## CIRCULAR: REOPENING OF SCHOOL

Assalam-u-Alaikum

Parents / Guardians,

This is to inform you that as per the directions and guidelines issued by the government of UT of J& K for reopening of schools, the school is planning to commence physical (offline) classes in a phased manner from March 8, 2021. The school shall follow all safety protocols and measures as proposed by the district administration under prescribed SOP for reopening of the schools. You are requested to go through the instructions below carefully.

1. The school will reopen in a phased manner according to the schedule given below.

Date	Physical Classes	Online Classes
March 8, 2021	1 <sup>st</sup> to 6 <sup>th</sup>	STOP
March 11, 2021	UKG	STOP
March 15, 2021	LKG / NURSERY	STOP

2. In order to maintain the proper social distancing in the class as well as in the school bus, the students are advised to attend the school as per the given schedule.

- a. NURSERY, LKG, UKG -- On alternate days based on odd/ even roll no's.

- b. 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> -- Half of the class roll for 3 days.

THURSDAY/ FRIDAY/SATURDAY	Second Half Roll No's

3. All the students attending the physical classes must be properly dressed in their complete winter uniform.
4. Students are supposed to carry their own stationery items viz. pencil, eraser, and sharpener and well labeled crayon colour box so that they do not have to borrow any of these items from others for safety measures.
5. The school transport will be available on all routes for the students who have been already availing the school bus facility.
6. The parents must fill in the **Consent Form** which is annexed to the circular and submit it to the concerned teacher on the very first day of the school.

### **PLEASE NOTE**

The management of R. P. School is highly concerned about the health and safety of the students, teaching staff and non-teaching staff. In this regard, the school is strictly taking the following steps to ensure the high levels of hygiene within the school premises.

1. The school premises will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized on daily and weekly basis.
2. Classrooms will be sanitized every morning before the arrival of the students.
3. Sanitizers and soaps will be available near the washrooms for the students to wash their hands as many times as they use the toilet.
4. The school caretaking staff will be repeatedly and continuously cleaning the things including the door handles, table surfaces and washroom accessories which are often touched by the children.
5. The furniture in the classrooms has been arranged as per the guidelines and instructions issued by the government.
6. There shall be no Morning Assembly or any Sports Activity for the time being so that the physical contact among the groups is minimized.
7. School buses will be sanitized and cleaned before the students' board them.
8. The students on their arrival in the school will undergo **thermal scanning** and the students suffering from fever will be sent back home for precautionary measures. In this regard, parents are advised to let their wards stay at home even in case of minor illness.
9. It is mandatory for the students to use **face masks** as long as they are in the school and during their travel in the school bus.
10. Students must be carrying their own water bottles and lunch so that they do not share water or eatables among themselves.
11. Parents are advised not to pay unnecessary visits to school except in case of emergency. However, they are free to call or email us for any kind of assistance.

We would like to thank you for being cooperative and supportive during the times of crisis when the school had no alternative other than to continue with online classes. We believe that we will be continuously receiving your support in the times to come.

The school is opening almost after a year and a half; it is likely that the students may take a good deal of time to get adjusted with the new atmosphere which is very challenging for the school to deal with.

However, we assure you that the school along with its teaching and non-teaching staff will take every precaution to ensure the safety of our loved ones.
